

## ***Clinician (Head Volleyball Coach)***

---

### **Purpose**

The Clinician (Head Volleyball Coach) position is responsible for instructing and overseeing the site volunteer coaches in the team instruction of the fundamentals of volleyball.

### **Specific Duties and Responsibilities**

- 1) Organize, instruct, supervise and maintain the volunteer coaches.
- 2) Assign equipment to the volunteer coaches.
- 3) Be First Aid and CPR certified.
- 4) Keep sensitive information under supervision.
- 5) Run a 30-minute orientation meeting for parents before the start of the season.
- 6) Direct volunteer coaches how to perform volleyball drills.
- 7) Demonstrate proper volleyball fundamentals to volunteer coaches and players.
- 8) Run home game days and inter site game days.
- 9) Communicate with the USYVL National Office.
- 10) Forward paperwork to USYVL National Office.

### **Qualifications and Desired Skills**

- 1) Must have experience playing volleyball and/or coaching volleyball at the high school, club, college or higher level. Equivalent experience can include being a proficient recreational volleyball player.
- 2) Be able to give clear and precise directions.
- 3) Be dependable.

### **Supervision Protocols**

While performing as the Clinician, the person is:

- 1) Subject to the bylaws, rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and guidelines of USYVL.
- 2) Under the overall authority of and directly supervised by USYVL.
- 3) For the protection of both the children and the volunteer, no child is with less than two adults at any given time, meaning a child is never to be in the company of a single – one -- adult during USYVL-sponsored activities.

### **Time Commitment**

The anticipated time commitment for a Clinician is the full eight-week season, plus the parent orientation. The estimated hours to fulfill the duties shall be 3-4 hours per week.

## **Orientation, Training, Certification and Continued Education Provided**

To prepare a person for the position of Clinician, USYVL will offer the following educational opportunities. It is the duty of the Clinician to attend these sessions.

- 1) Orientation by the USYVL.
- 2) Workshop on the USYVL Curriculum and Clinician responsibilities, duties, and procedures.

## **Activity Locations**

While performing the duties of Clinician (Volleyball Head Coach), the person is limited to their site, unless expressly authorized in writing by USYVL to hold activities in another location.
